Wednesday, July 26:

Depart Indianapolis for flight to Stuttgart

Thursday, July 27 : Upon arrival in Stuttgart, we will have a bus to transport us to the center of town where we will take a short tour of the area with a break for lunch. After lunch we will visit the Mercedes Benz museum, which is the only museum in the world that can document in a single continuous timeline the 130 years of auto industry history from its very beginnings to the present day. On nine levels and covering a floor space of 16,500 square metres, the museum presents 160 vehicles and over 1,500 exhibits. As a place of innovation, it also demonstrates that history can point the way ahead. After our tour, we will check into our 5 star hotel, the Hotel Am Schlossgarten, www.hotelschlossgarten.com/en. We will enjoy a welcome dinner tonight.



Friday, July 28: Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and then travel to Sinsheim to visit the Auto and Technik Museum.. Their spectacular collection includes over 300 vintage cars, “American Dream Cars” collection from the 1950s and 40 race and sports cars. The museum has over 3000 exhibits. All around are hundreds of cars- from modern to Formula One racers and Le Mans-winning sports cars to American iron and rows of Mercedes (including Heinrich Himmler's personal cars). Hundreds of motorcycles, 22 locomotives and all types of German and American military vehicles complete this impressive collection.

This afternoon, we will visit Heidelberg, a town of 150,000 inhabitants located in the Rhine Rift valley. After a stop for lunch, we will have a guided tour of the old town and the magnificent castle that stands guard over the ancient city. We return to our Stuttgart hotel.



Saturday, July 29: Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before we check out of our hotel. Before we leave Stuttgart, we visit the Porsche Museum. One of the greatest and most spectacular building projects in the history of Dr. Ing. h.c. F. Porsche AG was completed in December 2008: the new Porsche Museum in Stuttgart-Zuffenhausen. Located directly in the very heart of this unique sports car company so rich in tradition, the Museum serves to present the fascinating thrill and diversity of the Porsche brand to visitors from all over the world.



More than 80 cars are on display in the 5,600 square meters (60,250 square feet) Exhibition Area styled and designed futuristically by the Viennese architects Delugan Meissl, ranging from the legendary wheel hub motor of the Lohner-Porsche, the world's first hybrid automobile built as far back as in 1900, all the way to the latest generation of the Porsche 911.

Following our visit, we drive to Munich where we check into the beautiful Sofitel Hotel. www.sofitel-munich.com/en. This 5-star hotel in Munich is based in a magnificent, Wilhelminian building in the heart of the city. Experience the metropolitan design and city history in the historical post office in Munich.

Sunday, July 30 After breakfast at our hotel, we will take a special tour into the darkest part of German history as we visit the memorial site of Nazi Concentration Dachau. We will see an introduction video before we have time to explore the area in our individual pace with audio guides.

Back in Munich, we will enjoy a guided tour of the historic center of the city followed by some free time for shopping. Tonight we enjoy dinner in one of the classic bier gardens of the city.

Monday, July 31 Enjoy breakfast and then we depart hotel for a guided sightseeing tour of the BMW Museum. This museum shows BMW's technical development throughout the company's history. It contains engines and turbines, aircraft, motorcycles, and vehicles in a plethora of possible variations. In addition to actual models there are futuristic-looking, even conceptual studies from the past 20 years.



After our visit to the museum with a lunch stop, we will depart for Vilshofen to board the river cruise.

Monday, July 31 : Upon arrival in Vilshofen we will join our fellow passengers at a private Oktoberfest celebration in Vilshofen, with traditional beers and Bavarian folk music and dancing. Later, enjoy a festive Welcome Dinner aboard the ship.

Tuesday, August 1: Vilshofen, Germany

This morning you are free to explore Vilshofen's beautiful old town before cruising to Passau. This afternoon you will have a walking tour of this 2,000-year-old city, noted for its Gothic and Italian Baroque architecture, cobblestone streets, Rathaus, Domplatz and Residenzplatz squares, as well as St. Stephen's Cathedral.

Wednesday, August 2 : Linz, Austria

The ship arrives this morning in Linz. Enjoy a walking tour of the second largest city in Austria or choose a guided bike tour that will show you around the Old City Center, along the Danube River, and past the ultra-modern Ars Electronica Center. Later, you will have a choice of three different excursions. The first option is an excursion to Salzburg, Mozart's birthplace, where you will take a walking tour of the historic center made famous by "The Sound of Music." The second option is an excursion to the Czech town of Cesky Krumlov, a wonderfully preserved medieval town nestled in the hills just over the Austrian-Czech border. The third option is a visit to the Austrian Lake District, the scenic Salzkammergut region. All three regions are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.



Thursday, August 3: Wiessenhirchen

Cruise through the narrow Strudengau this morning en route to Weissenkirchen. You have three choices of how to explore Dürnstein today. The first is a walking tour along the town's cobblestone streets followed by a visit to the magnificent Benedictine Abbey at Melk, one of Europe's largest and most famous monastic sites, home to religious relics and a library filled with medieval manuscripts. Alternatively, you may join a hike up to the fortress where Richard the Lionheart was once held for ransom, or enjoy an Apricots and Sweets tasting instead. Tonight, after dinner on board, enjoy a wine tasting at a local winery

Friday August 4: Vienna

This morning, you will have a chance to savor the Baroque elegance of romantic Vienna through your choice of one of three different excursions. The first option is a panoramic tour of Vienna that guides you past the majestic Opera House, the former Imperial Palace of the Habsburg Emperors, Parliament, Town Hall and Vienna University. Afterwards, you will visit Vienna's historic city center, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and see St. Stephen's Cathedral, Graben and the world famous Spanish Riding School. The second option is a walking tour of Vienna's hidden treasures that takes you to secret places and sights like Ankeruhr, a whimsical Art Nouveau clock. Your third option is a guided bike tour along the Danube and through the Donaupark. This afternoon, you can join a guided bike ride to Klosterneuburg Monastery, or explore at your leisure. Be sure to sample some Viennese coffee and pastries



Saturday, August 5 : Bratislava, Slovakia

Enjoy a scenic morning cruise to Bratislava, where you will have three choices of excursions. The first is a walking tour that includes the Old Town Hall, Mirbach Palace and St. Martin's Cathedral. The second is a Slovakian Specialties tasting where you will enjoy a welcome glass of sparkling wine, sample a creamy soup made from sheep's cheese and learn how to prepare stuffed potato ravioli. Finally, you can also join a hike up to Bratislava Castle, which includes visits to the Castle Upper Terrace and Court of Honor. The remainder of the day is free to explore on your own.

Sunday, August 6: Budapest

Your morning excursion includes sightseeing in the cities of Buda and Pest spread over both banks of the river. You will see famed Heroes' Square and Castle Hill, home to



Fisherman's Bastion, Matthias Church and spectacular views of the Danube. Alternatively, you may also opt to join a hike up to Castle Hill on which you will see Buda Castle, Fisherman's Bastion and Parliament Square. After dinner, the ship will sail a special Illuminations Cruise past the glittering riverfront of Budapest.
