Monday, July 23:

Depart Indianapolis for flight to **Lisbon**.



Tuesday, July 24 : Upon arrival in Lisbon, we will have a bus to transport us to Porto to join our fellow passengers on the AmaVida. This riverboat has only 106 passengers and is an intimate journey up the Duoro River. This evening enjoy a festive Welcome Dinner aboard the ship.

Wednesday, July 25: Porto, Portugal

The colorful city of Porto blends the best of the old and the new, which you can discover on a guided tour of the historic quarter, a UNESCO World Heritage site, including the Cathedral, one of the city's oldest monuments; and the Sao Bento Railway Station, known for its blue and white tile panels depicting scenes from Portuguese history. You'll enjoy a tasting of Port, Portugal's most renowned contribution to the world of wine at Graham's winery. Prefer to get more active, you can hike to Graham's winery, offering magnificent views over the Duoro River.



Thursday, July 26 : Porto, Portugal

Visit Guimarães, one of the most historic towns in Portugal and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The birthplace of Portugal's first king, Guimarães claims to be "the cradle of the nation" and boasts a historic center that is one of the most attractive and best preserved in all of Portugal. You also have the option to go on the Jewish heritage tour through the Jewish Quarter of the city discovering the fascinating Jewish heritage.

Friday, July 27: Régua, Portugal

The breathtaking Douro River Valley is on full display as you sail along beautiful stretches of the river. Once arriving in Entre-os-Rios, you'll be taken to Quinta da Avelada, a historic, family-owned wine estate known as one of the best wine producing estates in the Vinho Verde region. Upon arrival, you'll enjoy a tour followed by a delicious wine and cheese tasting and then a special dinner. While here, wander through the Quinta Aveleda's gardens, where you'll find a thatched house for geese, peacocks and graceful swans



Saturday July 28: Régua, Portugal

Travel to picturesque Lamego, home to one of the most important pilgrimage sites in all of Portugal, where you'll go to the Nossa Senhora dos Remédios (Sanctuary of Our Lady of Remedies). The shrine features a staircase of nearly 700 steps, beautifully decorated with white and blue tiles, which for the more active adventurer will want to hike. Concluding the walking and hiking tours, you will have the opportunity to sample local traditional specialties, such as Bôlas de Lamego, bread filled with smoked ham; Presunto, a type of dry-cured ham; and Espumante, a Portuguese sparkling wine. Afterwards, you'll go to the formal Episcopal Palace Museum. For an alternative excursion, hike through the terraced

vineyards of Quinta da Pacheca, and then enjoy a lovely picnic overlooking the Douro River.

Sunday, July 29 : Pinhão

Enjoy an excursion to the Palacio de Mateus, located in the beautiful region of Trás-os-Montes near the city of Vila Real. The interior of the house features various religious images and exquisite furniture, artwork and hand-wooden ceilings. The exterior is equally stunning, with gardens that are among the most beautiful in all of Portugal. Afterwards, visit Quinta da Roêda, where you can discover the secrets of the vineyards as you take a guided walking tour through the property before enjoying lunch. Later in the day, go on an exclusive private tour of Quinta do Seixo's wine cellars, learning about the Douro Valley's centuries-old wine making methods before sampling some of the wines.



Monday, July 30: Vega Terrón

Venture to Castelo Rodrigo, known as the "White Village" because of its almond trees. The site offers spectacular views of the surrounding area and as far away as Spain. Join a walking tour through its medieval streets and see the houses and establishments with 16th-century facades. At the end of both tours, enjoy a tasting of local favorites, such as almonds, cheese, bread and wine.

LISBON

Friday July 20 Depart US

Saturday, July 21 Arrive in Lisbon, Portugal's capital city, and transfer to your hotel. The remainder of the day and evening is free to explore on your own

Sunday, July 22 One of Europe's most beautiful cities, Lisbon sprawls across several hills along the Tagus River. See Belem Tower, a fortified 4-story tower made of limestone, and visit the Late Gothic Jerónimos Monastery, the burial place of many Portuguese kings and heroes. The rest of the afternoon is free for you to explore the city's other top sights, such as the Castle of São Jorge or the Santa Justa Elevator that overlooks the castle, river and Rossio Square.

Monday, July 23 Enjoy an excursion to Serra de Sintra, former home of the Portuguese royal family, one of the most picturesque mountain villages in Portugal and a source of inspiration for generations of poets. You will have a guided tour of the Pena National Palace, a fairy tale castle from Portugal's Romantic period, situated high up on a rocky peak

Tuesday, July 24 Today you will leave Lisbon behind and will take the TGV high-speed train to Porto to board your ship. This evening, meet your fellow travelers at the Welcome Dinner. The ship moors overnight in Porto.

MADRID

Three night Post-cruise in Lisbon

Tuesday, July 31 You will disembark your ship and head off for a full-day tour of Salamanca, a UNESCO World Heritage Site located at the center of Spain's Castilla y León region. Your guided city tour includes the university buildings, the 12th-century Romanesque church of San Martin, the House of Shells, and also some free time to explore the city on your own. Later, you will be transferred to Madrid and check in to your hotel

Wednesday, August 1 Today you will have a guided tour of Madrid, the capital and largest city in Spain. Known for its many historic districts as well as its modern infrastructure, the city's top landmarks include the elaborate Royal Palace, Buen Retiro Park, Plaza Mayor, and world-renowned art galleries such as the Prado Museum and Centro de Arte Reina Sofia

Thursday, August 2 Enjoy an unforgettable excursion to the walled city of Toledo, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and ancient capital of Spain. Populated since pre-Roman times, the city's landmarks include the Alcázar, Cathedral of Toledo and the El Greco Museum

Friday, August 3 Your river cruise vacation comes to an end as you prepare for your homeward flight.

The price is based upon cash or check payments. Payment by credit card will incur an additional fee of 3%.

Payment Schedule:

A deposit of \$500. per traveler will be due by September 1, 2017.

An additional payment of \$2500.00 will be due February 15, 2018.

Final Payment as invoiced will be due May 15, 2018.

Additional Deposit of \$250 per traveler if one or both of the extensions is chosen.

Cancellation:

Once you have made a payment, If you must cancel before 120 days prior to the trip, you will be entitled to a full refund. Between 120 days and 30 days prior to the trip, you will be entitled to a refund of the total trip cost less the cost of the airline ticket and any non refundable deposits paid to hotels and other vendors. If you cancel less than 30 days prior, there will be no refund. If you cancel after 120 days prior and the airfare has been paid, you may be entitled to an airline credit less the change fee assessed by the airline. Usually you have one year to use the value of the ticket minus the change fee set by the airline, currently at \$300.00. Cancellations after 120 days will incur a \$100 administrative fee.

Trip Insurance:

Trip insurance may be purchased to protect the cost of the trip in case of a last minute emergency. To cover pre-existing conditions, trip insurance must be purchased within 14 days of the initial deposit. Once you have placed a deposit for this trip, I will provide you with a brochure that you may choose to use.

Baggage: Most airlines allow for one free checked bag on international flights. You will be charged for a second checked bag. Please check the website for specific prices. You will be allowed a small carryon and one personal bag. Please be sure you meet the specifications for the carry on bag so you are not surprised with a charge at check in.
