

# Everyone has been talking about Hamilton!! Now you can see it! March 29, 2017

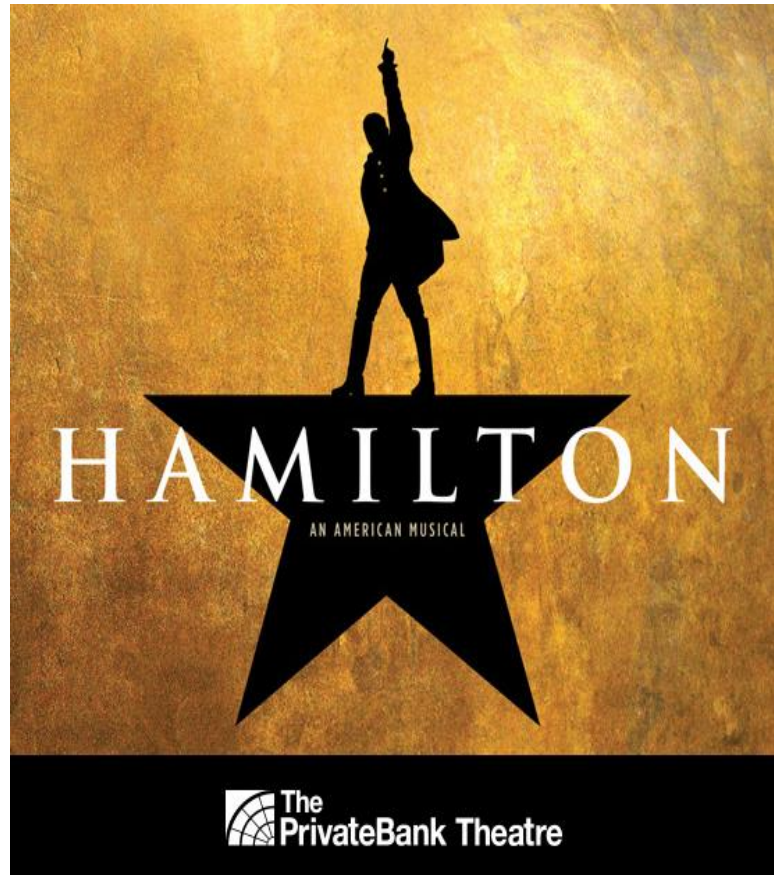

## Wednesday, March 29, 2017

This morning we will depart from Indianapolis by bus for the drive to Chicago. We will check in at the Chicago Hyatt Hotel on Wacker Drive, located right in between the Magnificent Mile and the legendary State Street.

Enjoy a walk down Michigan Avenue and enjoy the city as it transforms into another springtime.

Tonight we will meet for a group dinner followed by our chance to see Broadway's biggest hit of all time.

**Thursday, March 30** Today is a free day to enjoy the sights and sounds of Chicago and catch up on your shopping. You might make a lunch reservation at the famous Walnut Room located in Macy's on State Street or enjoy an architecture cruise on the Chicago River.

We will depart from the Hyatt hotel at 3:00 p.m for our return bus ride to Indianapolis.

The cost for this package trip to Chicago will be \$649.00 per person. (double occupancy) and includes our bus transportation from Indianapolis to Chicago, one night at the Chicago Hyatt Regency Hotel, a group dinner before the show on Wednesday and tickets for HAMILTON. Single supplement is available.

**Payment Schedule:**

A deposit of \$200.00 per traveler will be due by November 30, 2016.  
Final Payment as invoiced will be due February 1, 2017

**Cancellation:**

Once you have made a payment, If you must cancel before 120 days prior to the trip, you will be entitled to a full refund. Between 120 days and 30 days prior to the trip, you will be entitled to a refund of the total trip cost less the cost of any non refundable deposits paid to hotels and other vendors. If you cancel less than 30 days prior, there will be no refund. Cancellations after 120 days prior to the trip will incur a \$100 administrative fee.

**Trip Insurance:**

Trip insurance may be purchased to protect the cost of the trip in case of a last minute emergency. To cover pre-existing conditions, trip insurance must be purchased within 14 days of the initial deposit. Once you have placed a deposit for this trip, I will provide you with a brochure that you may choose to use.
