Wednesday , April 4, 2018  
*The 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Assassination of Dr. King*

We depart on an early morning bus trip to  
Memphis with a lunch stop on the way.



This afternoon, we will visit the National Civil Rights Museum at the Lorraine Motel, the location of the assassination of Dr. King. We will participate in the special activities sponsored by the Museum in memory of Dr King.

We check into our downtown Memphis hotel and gather for a welcome dinner  
Overnight in Memphis – Holiday Inn

Thursday, April 5, 2018



After breakfast at the hotel, we will drive to Birmingham, Alabama to visit the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Baptist Church, the site of the church bombing on September 16, 1963 when four young girls were killed. The church is next door to the Birmingham Civil Rights Institute. After a visit in the museum, we will have lunch in a local restaurant.

Following lunch, we continue on to Montgomery and check into Montgomery Embassy Suites Hotel. We will take a short tour of Montgomery and see the site of the bus boycott and visit the Rosa Parks Museum. Overnight in Montgomery.

Friday, April 6, 2018: Enjoy breakfast at the Hotel



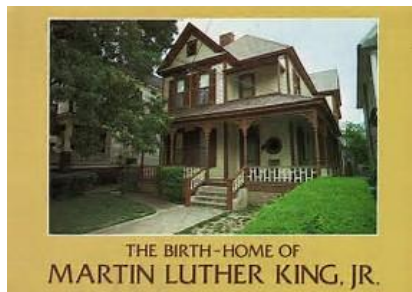
Travel to Selma to relive the moment of the Crossing of the Edmund Pettus bridge. The southern approach of the Edmund Pettus Bridge is where “a sea of blue” law enforcement officers attacked marchers with tear gas and nightsticks on “Bloody Sunday,”

March 7, 1965

We will return to Montgomery. Lunch is on your own. This afternoon we visit Dexter Ave. Baptist Church and Dr. King's home. Overnight in Montgomery.

Saturday, April 7, 2018:

After breakfast at the hotel, we drive to Atlanta and visit the Martin Luther King Jr. National Historic Site and the Center for Nonviolent Social Change. You will have a chance to sit in the Ebenezer Baptist Church where Dr. King was pastor.



Visit the birth home of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr and the grave of Dr. King and Coretta Scott King.

This afternoon, we will have an early dinner to reflect on our experiences before we head to the airport and fly home to Indianapolis this evening.

**Cost:** The cost will be \$895.00 per person (double occupancy) and includes all bus transportation from Indianapolis to Memphis, Birmingham, Montgomery, Selma and Atlanta with a return flight to Indianapolis from Atlanta.

Three nights in hotels (dbl occupancy)  
two group dinners, two group lunches, daily breakfast and Museum admissions.

Not included: personal gratuities; excursions, wines, liquors, mineral waters and meals not mentioned in the itinerary, travel insurance; all items of a strictly personal nature

**Payment Schedule:** A deposit of \$200. per traveler will be due to confirm the space by August 15, 2017

A second payment of \$350 will be due October 15, 2017  
Final Payment as invoiced will be due January 15, 2018.

**Cancellation:** Once you have made a payment, If you must cancel before 120 days prior to the trip, you will be entitled to a full refund. Between 120 days and 30 days prior to the trip, you will be entitled to a refund of the total trip cost less the cost of the airline ticket and any non refundable deposits paid to hotels and other vendors. If you cancel less than 30 days prior, there will be no refund. If you cancel after 120 days prior and the airfare has been paid, you may be entitled to an airline credit less the change fee assessed by the airline. Usually you have one year to use the value of the ticket minus the change fee set by the airline. Cancellations after 120 days prior to the trip will incur a \$50 administrative fee.

**Trip Insurance:** Trip insurance may be purchased to protect the cost of the trip in case of a last minute emergency. To cover pre-existing conditions, trip insurance must be purchased within 14 days of the initial deposit. Once you have placed a deposit for this trip, I will provide you with a brochure that you may choose to use.

**Baggage:** Checked baggage fees vary by airline. For most domestic routes, you will be charged \$25.00 per checked bag. Please check the website for specific prices. You will be allowed a small carryon and one personal bag. Please be sure you meet the specifications for the carry on bag so you are not surprised with a charge at check in.

**Selection of Vendors:** Travel to Remember, LLC will use the following guidelines for the selection of international and domestic land and air suppliers. All suppliers will be chosen from those recommended by other known and trusted vendors in our industry. We will look for suppliers that have a proven track record for safety and a reputation for being the most experienced local receptive operators.
