**Day 1: Thursday, June. 3...** Depart the USA for our tour of England

**Day 2: Friday, June 4** We arrive in London, England and drive to Windsor, where we will stop for lunch and check into our hotel located just opposite Windsor Castle,



This afternoon, visit Windsor Castle for a self guided tour and then this evening, enjoy a welcome dinner cruise on the Thames River. Overnight in Windsor at the MacDonald Windsor hotel directly across from Windsor Castle. **Day 3: Saturday, June 5** This morning, after breakfast, we take a short drive to Stonehenge, a World Heritage site and the best known prehistoric monument in Europe.

Take time for lunch and then we head on to Bristol, the birthplace of Methodism. See the New Room, John Wesley's chapel built in 1739 where he started to preach to the poor. The new museum tells the story of Wesley in the 18<sup>th</sup> century and how the movement grew and developed across the country. There is also a focus on how Methodism expanded to America.

**Day 4: Sunday, June 6** This morning, we will be the featured choir in the morning worship service at a local Methodist church, followed by a time of fellowship with the local congregation. This afternoon, enjoy some free time at the wharf area near the hotel along with dinner on your own.

This evening, we will present a full concert in the St. Mary's Cathedral in downtown Bristol.

**Day 5, Monday, June 7** After breakfast at our hotel, we drive to Stratford on the Avon, home of William Shakespeare. See Shakespeare's grave and the current Globe Theatre. After lunch, we will transfer to the Coombe Abbey Hotel and enjoy an included dinner.



**Day 6, Tuesday, June 8** Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and then we drive towards Oxford. On our way, we will stop at the Coventry Cathedral. On the night of 14 November 1940, the city of Coventry was devastated by bombs dropped by the Luftwaffe. The Cathedral burned with the city, having been hit by several incendiary devices. Shortly after the destruction, the cathedral stonemason noticed that two of the charred medieval roof timbers had fallen in the shape of a cross. He set them up in the ruins where they were later placed on an altar of rubble with the moving words 'Father Forgive' inscribed on the Sanctuary wall.

We continue on to Oxford, where John and Charles Wesley were both students of Lincoln College. Enjoy dinner on your own in this important city and visit the Eagle and Child, a local bar where C. S. Lewis and J. R.R. Tolkien spent many nights encouraging each other on their next projects. Overnight in Oxford at the MacDonald Randolph Hotel in central Oxford.

The rest of the afternoon is free to visit the other sites of London, including Westminster Abbey, the British Museum and Buckingham Palace. Tonight, we have a group included dinner. Overnight in London.

**Day 11: Sunday, June 13** This morning, we will have our last singing opportunity as guest choir at the Methodist Central Hall at their Sunday morning service. For those heading back to Indianapolis, you will depart for the airport following the worship service.

**Day 11, Sunday, June 13** Transfer to Edinburgh by Train from London. Check into our hotel.



**Monday, June 14** After breakfast, we walk the Miracle mile and Tour Edinburgh Castle. This afternoon, choose from a Whiskey Tasting or Underground vault tour. Dinner on your own.



**Tuesday, June 15** We leave early for an all day tour to Loch Ness, Glencoe and the Highlands. Lunch is on your own but we return to Edinburgh in time for a group dinner.

**Wednesday, June 16** Depart for home.

For all flights, You will need to provide information from your passport, your name, exactly as it appears on your passport along with your date of birth, passport number and the passport expiration date.

To cover pre-existing conditions, trip insurance must be purchased within 14 days of the initial deposit.
